II. REQUIRED FINANCIAL DOCUMENTATION

1. You are required to document the sum of U.S. \$32,500 for your expenses for the 2005-2006 calendar year (September-August) at the University of New Hampshire, exclusive of travel expenses to and from the U.S. The breakdown of estimated expenses is \$29,800 for the academic year (September-May) and \$2700 for the summer (June-August). You must indicate how you will meet your expenses for subsequent years of study if you expect your program to require more than one year. Plan for annual increase of 6%.
2. This form, together **with the official documentation as noted below**, should be submitted with your application for admission to UNH. Since you will also need to show financial documentation when you apply for your visa at a U.S. Consulate, we suggest that you keep a separate set of original documents. **Forms returned to UNH without complete financial documentation for the 2005-2006 year will delay the issuance of the Form I-20 or DS-2019.** If you are unsure of your source of funding, please complete this section to the best of your ability and submit supporting financial documentation when it becomes available.
3. It is absolutely essential that you have sufficient funds to support yourself and any dependents during your entire academic program. Employment for F-1 or J-1 students is strictly regulated and you should not expect to meet your educational expenses by working.
