Information regarding the possibility of any other course in English -in any other field than philologies- will be sent to the students directly, together with a list of courses and codes updated prior their coming. We are working on it, nevertheless, in the Centres/Departments page can be found too (see above).

Please, remember that your students can do their learning agreement once here, not necessarily before they arrive in the UEx, and also, that they can choose any course from any level and campus of the UEx, it will be you -their home university- who will decide if the choice is the right one as to be formally validated afterwards.

The academic calendar is not fixed yet by the institution, but we are warning the students to come in the last week of September, when we can have it all ready for them, and when they have the time to settle before the classes start, probably, very end of that September or first week of October.
