#### **ERASMUS Application Procedure**

<u>Deadline for student nominations</u> by your international office is <u>May 15<sup>th</sup></u> for the <u>winter term</u> and <u>November 15<sup>th</sup></u> for the <u>summer term</u>. Nominations must be submitted to Ms Julia Freier and also to the respective departmental coordinator. Please provide correct Email-addresses of all nominated students as further correspondence will take place per Email. Please also state the ERASMUS subject area of the nominated students!

Once nominated by the sending institution students are required to fill in the <u>online ERASMUS</u> <u>application form</u>. The online application form will be made available by Mid-April for students coming in the fall term, and by the beginning of November for students coming in the summer term. After transmitting the online application, students have to generate the application form as PDF document with Adobe Acrobat and have it signed by their coordinator before mailing it to the International Office.

Please note: The online-application is only valid if signed and stamped by the home university!

<u>Complete student documents</u> must reach Ms Freier by <u>June 15<sup>th</sup> for the winter term</u> or December 15<sup>th</sup> for the summer term at the latest.
