Accommodation	Alexandru Ioan Cuza University offers accommodation for its Erasmus students in
	Gaudeamus Centre for International Exchanges, situated in the campus, within walking distance from the main University Building, the University Library, and "Titu Maiorescu" Students' Canteen. Places are available in double or triple rooms, fully furnished, including a TV set and a refrigerator. Each room has a private bathroom and a little balcony. Access to Internet is possible without making a special request. There is a kitchen fully equipped for cooking on each floor. The accommodation fee to be paid is 490 LEI/month (approx. 120 Euro) for a place in a double room or triple room. It is not possible to choose a single room.
