Registration:	Some days after your arrival, an appointment will be fixed with the admissions department. A letter of admission from our service is requested.</p> <p>Residence permit : If the stay is longer than 3 months in France, a residence permit is needed. You should apply for it at the <i>OFII</i> (Office Français de l'Immigration et d'Intégration).</p> <p>Health insurance : If the stay is longer than 3 months, you must pay in France the student health insurance (about 200€)</p>												
<p>Language of teaching:</p>	<p>All courses are taught in French</p>												
<p>French courses for exchange students:</p>	<p>3h per week, all through the academic year, at different levels (language tests are organized at the first course in October), free of charge.</p>
