| | Third Party Liability Insurance It is the responsibility of the student to take out insurance (from home) for your personal belongings, accidents and third party liability while studying in Germany. TU Berlin does not cover any losses that may occur. |
| Additional fees to pay | If staying in a dormitory, students are required to pay a deposit of one months' rent. |
| Student jobs available/allowed | It is difficult to find a student job in Berlin and foreign students cannot base their economy on the chance of getting a job. |
