Upon individual arrangement – German language skills not required, proficiency in English is sufficient.

CLINICAL ROTATIONS / ELECTIVES

In our clinical system, interns are expected to work full days. It is not possible to arrange part-time assignments. Thus, students are not allowed to take courses parallel to hospital work. Of course, hospital work can be arranged before or after the lecture period/during semester breaks. Minimum duration for hospital assignments is 4 weeks (per station).

LANGUAGE COURSE INFORMATION

Intensive German Language Course (<i>pre-session</i>)	3 ECTS. Students can take this course only once: before the start of their studies or in between two semesters (not at the end of their stay). Usually, 3 levels are offered (Beginners, Elementary, Intermediate). Advanced German can only be offered if there are enough participants.
German Language Course (<i>semester course</i>)	3 ECTS. Usually, 2 levels are offered in continuation of the intensive German Language Course (Beginners, Elementary)
Other Language Courses	The Center for Languages and Philology (Zentrum für Sprachen und Philologie – ZSP) offers further German courses as well as courses in many other languages: http://www.zsp.uni-ulm.de

ORIENTATION PERIOD

The International Office organizes a month-long orientation period in fall and spring prior to the beginning of each semester. The offer includes the Intensive German Language Course and an intercultural training course “Living and Studying in Germany” (3 ECTS) besides excursions, films and many other events. Accepted students will receive a detailed program.

HOUSING

International Office assists with finding accommodation in student residences if students mark the appropriate sections in their application form. However, to high demand we cannot guarantee that every student receives a room or a room in their preferred location.
