

Incoming ERASMUS students Guidelines:

- ✓ Your Erasmus office should send via email your Erasmus nomination
- ✓ Send your complete Erasmus Application file **by 15th of June** (for winter semester) & **by 15th of October** (for spring semester)

Bear in mind that:

- ✓ Any applications received by the University of the Aegean after the deadline will not be processed
- ✓ Incomplete applications will also not be processed

Language Requirements

All the incoming students are required to have a good command of the English language prior to their arrival. We strongly recommend upgrading your level before coming to our University since most of your written essays or your oral exams will be in English.

For admission to University of the Aegean at BSc and MSc level the requirements are

A TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score of at least 80 (internet based test)

Or IELTS (academic version) overall band score of at least 5.5

Or the First Certificate in English, University of Cambridge or University of Michigan

MSc Students who wish to do their Master thesis in our University are responsible for contacting the Department in order to be allocated a suitable supervisor depending on their subject. **The agreement of supervision should be done prior to student's arrival.**
