## CONCERNING ERASMUS EXCHANGE

We are pleased to inform you that the 2011-2012 application procedure for students wishing to study at the Université de Nantes - as Erasmus or as students taking part in an International Exchange Convention - is now available on-line at the following site:

Please note that the online application procedure is compulsory. Only complete and signed application forms, along with all the necessary documents, will be accepted.

All **1<sup>st</sup> semester/full academic year** applications must be received by **15<sup>th</sup> May 2012**.

All **2<sup>nd</sup> semester** applications must be received by **30<sup>th</sup> November 2012**.

We would like to remind you that the Université de Nantes offers free French language support classes to all its exchange students. This includes a week long intensive course, available only 1<sup>st</sup> semester, and night classes during the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (4 hours per week).

Starting **1st July 2012** onwards, we will send an email to confirm whether university accommodation has been reserved for candidates. Please note that reservation periods are fixed as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> September - 31<sup>st</sup> May
- or 1<sup>st</sup> September - 15<sup>th</sup> January
- or 15<sup>th</sup> January - 31<sup>st</sup> May
