Erasmus Application Procedure 2012/13

Dear Partner

please find herewith the relevant application document for this coming winter semester 2012/13: Application form for admission: Zulassungsantrag

Application form for accommodation 2012/13: Application documents concerning accommodation are not available yet. However, we shall send them out as soon as possible and in due time (Thanks for your understanding).

Do allow me to bring up the following points to your attention:

1. No student shall be admitted without prior nomination by her/his home university (an Email from the home university stating the name, address and email address of the student as well as the length of her/his stay is fully sufficient. This email should be sent to: erasmus@io.uni-saarland.de). Please make sure you also send the names of the nominated students to the departmental coordinator concerned in Saarbrücken.

2. Once the student has been officially nominated, we send application documents directly over to her/him. We'd be most grateful if your students could use a computer to fill out the forms; indeed, we only send information per email and it is sometimes very difficult to decipher the handwriting of some of the students; as a consequence, those students do not receive the information on time, or even worse: they never receive it at all!! Please ask your students to use easily recognizable and traceable email addresses. Thanks for your most appreciated help regarding that matter!

3. Please note that the admission is final only once we have received the "Zulassungsantrag" (this also applies to the students who already sent the usual ECTS application form).

4. We send a letter of acceptance to all the students provided we received their "Zulassungsantrag".

5. Deadlines for application for an entry in October 2012 (Winter semester 2012/13):
June 15, 2012.

6. As far as accommodation is concerned, we work on a "first come, first served basis". The sooner the application reaches us, the more chances your students have to get a room in a university residence.

7. a) Special Requirements for students of the Faculty of Medicine:

Please note that specific rules apply to the Erasmus students coming under area code 721 (Medicine). They actually study in Homburg where our Faculty of Medicine is located (it is some 30 km away from Saarbrücken); the admission and application procedures differ slightly and are to be dealt directly with the departmental coordinator of the Faculty of Medicine in Homburg:

7. b) Special Requirements for students from the University of Luxembourg:

8. The winter semester officially starts on October, 1, 2012. However, classes begin on October, 15, 2012. Therefore, our orientation sessions shall most probably take place during the days prior to the beginning of classes (presumably between the 8th and 12th of October 2012 - a more detailed programme as well as the final dates are still to be decided upon: they shall be communicated directly to the students at a later date).

Please note that the orientation sessions take place in Saarbrücken and therefore do not concern the medical students going to Homburg!!!
