Language Requirements / German Courses	<p>Courses at Graz University of Technology are generally offered in German, though several classes are also offered in English. Graz University of Technology needs to receive a proof of sufficient language qualification. Based on the chosen courses, students need to prove sufficient knowledge of either German or English (level B2 as minimum requirement).
