Application Deadlines	* Fall semester (Sept-Dec) or whole year = before June 1 st * Spring semester (Jan-June) = before October 15
Language Level Required	* French level DELF B1 for courses taught in French * English level 750 TOEIC for courses taught in English --Copy of an official test required--
Annexed Documents Required	* Learning agreement (<i>duly approved and signed by the home university coordinator</i>) * 3 last transcripts of records * Certificate of knowledge of foreign language * Accommodation application form * Proof of health insurance coverage (<i>Cf "Medical coverage/Insurance" in the student guide</i>) * Valid passport for non-EU students / Identity card for EU students * Birth certificate translated in French (<i>except EU students</i>)

Credits and Grading System	<p>LaSalle Beauvais is using the European Grade system (ECTS)</p> <p>Each semester may offer to students 30 ECTS credits if all exams are successfully completed (exam result > 10/20)</p> <p>Most of courses mix Lecture, Work, Group Work, Case Study, Practical Work, Practical Lab. Work, and Self Study</p>

Arrivals	<p>From Monday through Friday / from 9 to 12 am and from 2 to 5 pm</p> <p>Please inform in advance about schedule arrival in Beauvais in order to get the room key</p> <p>Possibility to pick up the student at Beauvais' train station or Beauvais's airport by the French buddy student</p> <p>Public transportation is also available (bus, train, taxi)</p>
Accommodation	<p><u>Priority for all international students who want to live on the campus</u></p> <p>The accommodation form must be filled and signed, enclosed to the application form, in order to book a room early July for study period during Fall semester, and early November for study period during Spring semester</p> <p>2 kind of rooms available:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *single room with private bathroom (€460 per month) *studio with 2 single rooms and shared bathroom (€230 per month) <p>French financial subsidiary (APL) to ask upon arrival.</p> <p><u>Contact:</u> International Relations- Maud Almendros</p>
Services and facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *A scenic 25 acre campus surrounded by 75 acres of private woodland, located in northern France, 50 miles to the north of Paris * Facilities to disabled students * A dining hall open 7 days a week * Laundry facilities * Sport facilities: a gymnasium, a fitness center, a squash court, 2 tennis courts, etc / free and unlimited * A library * Wireless computer access and 150 free computer stations * 1/3 extra time and a French dictionary offered during exams * A student center with more than 75 student organizations * French buddy student mentoring
Validation of exams	<p>All courses have written and oral exams, tests, personal and group work.</p> <p>In order to get ECTS credits / US credits you must complete them successfully with a minimum result of 10/20 or a grade between A to E.</p> <p><u>NB:</u> 1/3 extra-time + French language dictionary to realize exams</p>
Learn French as a foreign language	<p><u>2 levels:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *students from countries where French is spoken *students from countries where French is not spoken <p><u>Students registered for the degree "titre d'ingénieur"</u></p> <p>2 hours of French as a foreign language - 2 weeks a month = compulsory / 2 ECTS credits.</p> <p><u>Students registered for a non-degree academic mobility</u></p> <p>No obligation – possibility to follow 2 hours of courses per week.</p>
