

## Conditions for admission to the SELF program

Dear Partner,

Due to the increasing number of students in the SELF program, we have had to establish the following conditions and qualifications for admission to the SELF program. These conditions will apply from the August intake 2013/2014.

1. English level test for future SELF students – except for countries where English is the official language:

- TOEFL IBT: overall score of 80 or higher with 20 at least for each section – only the official test will accepted (the local institutional version is not adequate)
- IELTS: overall score of 6,5 and 6 minimum at each section
- TOEIC including speaking, writing, listening and reading test: overall score of 690
- Cambridge Advanced: A/B
- Cambridge Proficiency: C minimum

One of the English tests listed above is to be sent by e-mail along with your nominations.

The test must have been undertaken no more than **two years** prior to the commencement of the SELF program at Lyon 3.

### 2. Level of studies

We remind you that the SELF program is addressed to students in their BA degree year (at least 2 years of studies completed)

### 2. Course pre-selection

- With regard to substantial discrepancies between the course pre-selection and the final course selection, we have decided to ask for pre-selection approval by your side.

We would therefore kindly ask you to sign the pre-selection course form of your students and submit it on-line as a proof of approval. This form will be sent to the students who will forward it to you.

- Please note that the pre-selection does not guarantee a spot in the course requested. Spots in SELF classes are indeed limited and the final course selection will take place upon arrival as usual. The pre-selection helps us to assess the number of students in each course.

- We may require pre-requisites for business courses. You will be informed in due time.

- As usual, if a 5<sup>th</sup> content course is needed, we require an official note from the home University

### 3. French level

Regarding the French level, we remind you that the SELF program is designed for students whose French level is basic, i.e. lower than A2 and are not able to attend courses in French.

Students whose French is good enough to attend content courses in French will be transferred into the DEUF program.
