	the coordinators of your home institution (*) • Provisional list of courses – only non-ERASMUS students		
	Deadlines: June 1 (Winter term) / November 15 (Summer term)		
	In order to get their student card, incoming students must present at their arrival the following documents:		
	 A proof of enrolment at their home university the year of mobility. Without it, incoming students must pay the enrolment fees (180€) A copy of the European student health insurance – only ERASMUS students. Non-European students must pay the french insurance (200€). The payment of the medical control is obligatory (approx.5€). Payments must be by cash or credit card.

Admission	The UPEMLV sends by email to each registered students their acceptance letter in June (Winter term) / in November (Summer term).

Preparing the student stay			
Accommodation	Our service is not responsible for accommodation services, but we have an agreement with the CROUS, a public institution, which allows us 70 rooms:		
	The application form should be issued and sent with other forms mentioned above. We recommend to all interested students to send the form duly completed, as soon as possible. Indeed, we cannot lodge all students applying. "First come, first served!"		
	 Fees: 300 € - 400 €/month, depending on the room and the residence Deposit: 233€ Rent paid in advance: 3/6 months, depending on the period of stay 		
	Insurance: Students have to pay a house insurance (40 € to 80 €). Usually, the Civil responsibility insurance necessary to get the UPEMLV student card is included.		
	Financial aid: Student can receive a financial aid from the government called CAF. The application form is given at the arrival. Student must fill it out and deposit it to the CROUS (other justifications might be requested).		
French Autumn Course	Every academic year, at the beginning of September, the UPEMLV organizes 2 weeks of intensive french courses. Called UFAC, this program is a great opportunity for incoming students to improve their french level and to prepare them to follow the academic courses. Besides, this is an opportunity to meet other students sharing the same experience on the occasion of the activities scheduled.		
	Fees: • €150 • lunch included, except on week-end • only cultural activities scheduled included		
Visa & residence permit	Students from outside EU countries must apply for a visa. A letter of admission from our service is requested.		
	If the stay is longer than 3 months, a residence permit is needed. To apply for it: OFII (Office Français de l'Immigration et d'Intégration)
