Is university administered accommodation available to exchange students?	Yes. However, the number of rooms is limited. Université de Nantes cannot guarantee to meet all the accommodation requests for the exchange students.
If yes, do students send accommodation application to your office?	Exchange students at the University of Nantes, who wish to reserve a room in a university residence hall, must complete the 'accommodation section' on their online application form.
	Students are advised to submit hall residence application. Hall residence places are very limited and may not be guaranteed due to keen competition.
	Students can choose the type of room but not the residency.
	A description of the dorm and room will be sent to the students upon their room confirmation.
	Renovated rooms - private bathroom - approx. 238,33€ per month (including bills) Traditional rooms - hall bathroom - approx 153€ per month (including bills)
	Students must pay a security deposit upon arrival (roughly one month's rent) in case the room is damaged or if students fail to pay rent. If there are no problems at the end of the students' stay, the security deposit will be returned to them within six months after their departure.
	Please note that reservation periods for accommodation are fixed as follows:

Visa requirements

visa requirements	
Are exchange students required to obtain a student visa?	Students must contact the French consular or Campus France services in their country of residence at least 2 months before their departure to find out about visa requirements.  Generally, if the stay in France lasts for more than three months, the students must obtain a long-term student visa before their arrival in France.
	Citizens from the European Union, the European Economic Area, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, Switzerland, and the Vatican are not required to obtain a visa to study in France. Students who are part of the ERASMUS program but who are not citizens of one of the above mentioned entities must obtain a visa. Foreigners residing in a any of the following territories: European Union, the European Economic Area, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, Switzerland, and the Vatican, are allowed to stay a maximum of 90 days in France. Therefore, they must obtain a visa before coming to France.
Are exchange students allowed to work?	The type of visa that students obtain before they arrive in France determines whether or not they are allowed to work.  Students who are allowed to work in France must validate their
	visa upon arrival in order to have permission to work.  Foreign students are only allowed to work 884 hours per year (i.e approximately 20 hours per week, with the exception of academic holidays when they can work full time).

## Insurance

Are exchange students required to purchase a compulsory plan?	All E-U students must have their European health card. Non E-U students must pay 203€ for social security when they enrol at the university.* All students must purchase room insurance when they arrive in Nantes.
