First semester (October – February)/ whole academic year - May 15th, 2013

Second semester (February –June) - November 15th, 2013

We should receive the nominations at least two weeks prior to the deadline.

Language Requirements

Incoming Erasmus students are required to have at least a **B2** level of English and/or Polish

Please note that this rule does not apply to students nominated to study languages. They should have at least a B2 level of the language that they will study at the University of Warsaw.
