English language proficiency requirements	Bristol does not formally require Erasmus students to have specific English qualifications or scores however as a guideline it is strongly recommended that students have a minimum of 6.5 IELTS (100 TOFEL) - equivalent of B2. Certain subjects require a higher level of English; 7.0 IELTS for Law and Economics; 7.5 IELTS for English Literature and Drama

Accommodation	<p>We cannot offer Erasmus students university accommodation however the Accommodation Office can help with finding private housing. Accommodation costs vary greatly, private housing can cost from £360 to £500 per month, exclusive of bills.
