## Pay attention with the deadlines!

• Application deadline: 1st semester and full academic year: 15th May

2nd semester:

15th November

If your student wants to apply **ONLY for the second semester**, the period to register **starts the 1st September**!

## Barcelona/(residencias)/Barcelona/(reservas)/Curso

It is absolutely necessary that students bring to Spain:

- 1. The passport (or national identification card)
- 2. The Erasmus credential or certificate of your Erasmus acceptance (if you come under any other kind of programme, a similar document will be required) ORIGINAL-
- 3. Learning Agreement signed and stamped -ORIGINAL-
- 4. Updated transcript of records
- 5. A copy of the registration at your home university
- 6. 2 card photos
- 7. European insurance card or any international medical insurance

We also inform you that the first semester is going to start on September and finishes on December. Examinations will be on January. The second semester is going to start on February and finishes on May. Examinations will be on June and extraordinary examinations (for those students who don't pass the exam) on July.

Although the academic calendar for 2014/15 is not updated yet, you can have a look to the current course. Dates will have few modifications.

We are looking forward to continue our cooperation within the Erasmus+ scheme.
