

Choosing courses and semester workload

It is important that the students receive guidance from their home university when choosing courses, in order to minimize the risk of having to make changes after arrival.

We allow students to take courses from different faculties, but we recommend students to sign up for courses relevant to their core studies. By taking courses from only one faculty, the risk of timetable collisions is reduced.

The regular workload is 30 ECTS credits for one semester, and 60 ECTS credits for a whole year.

Nomination/Application process:

1. Partner university nominates student online and uploads the required documents
2. Student fills out the application form online

Required documents

- Transcript of Records – *Must be in English, Swedish or Danish, pdf file*. Please make sure that the document is up to date.
- Learning Agreement – *Erasmus+ students only*
- Certificate of Attendance / Certificate of Arrival / Certificate of Departure – (if relevant) To make administration easier, please upload your institutional form so that we can print it out, sign it during the first week and hand it out to the student.

Students applying for exchange studies in music, will need to send us a recording of a performance with their principal instrument. This may be a sound file sent by e-mail or a CD sent by post.

Language requirements

We require B1 English or Norwegian language knowledge depending on the language of instruction of the particular course the student wishes to take.

Incomplete and paper applications, as well as applications with supporting documents in other languages than those mentioned above, will not be processed.

Letter of Acceptance

Letters of Acceptance will be issued three weeks after the application deadline.
