From the University of Extremadura (E BADAJOZ 01), it is a pleasure to inform you that our **online application form** for Erasmus+ nominees 2015/2016 is going to be available during **May 2015**.

Their nominations should be got during that month too, both for annual, first and second semester. (Although, for the second semester a new period of time will be available around December).

We are updating all of the info these days, but you and your students can start having a look at it if you wish, for no important changes will be done on it, and given the case, it will be duly notified.

Please, let me give you some information on the whole procedure, addressed to the students:

<p>*We are afraid it is not possible to accept any student if this online application is not done, even if we get documents from you and emails with their nominations.</p> <p>**Once the online application is done, the students get an automatic response email with information and letter of acceptance -please, notice that such letter will be a non-personalised one. Turkish institutions have to ask for a personalized one, so that their students can properly apply for their Visa. Embassies are getting very demanding, so we advice the home institutions to ask for such personalized letter ASAP, please.</p>

**Turkish institutions must ask for the personalized letter of acceptance for the Visa of their students giving us all the necessary data asked by the embassies (which might change).		
Choose your future courses at the UEx on our web. Fill in a sample of learning agreement and get the <u>signature</u> of your coordinator there at home. Only students from Medicine and Nursing must send it before coming, the rest, you can bring it with you.	Get into any centre and click on "Grado" to see the courses in each Degree: http://www.unex.es/conoce-la-uex/centros and then, check its timetables getting into any centre and click on "Horarios". ***	No later than mid-July. (Medicine and Nursing students <i>post</i> it. The rest, can <i>bring</i> it with them.
*** Post your learning agreement to the UEx <u>ONLY</u> if your home university asks you so, otherwise, just <u>bring it with you!!</u> Medicine and Nursing ones must do before coming anyway.

Welcome Day /Orientation Days (Obligatory)	Both in Cáceres Campus and Badajoz Campus.	To be notified. Probably, first week of September/January.
