If there is a problem with the deadline, please tell us in advance.

Before the above mentioned date, DTU must have received the online application at <a href="www.icn.dtu.dk">www.icn.dtu.dk</a> and the required documents, which are also mentioned at the above webpage. The documents are a certified transcript, documentation for English language proficiency, and the learning agreement for Erasmus students. Concerning English language proficiency, as a general rule, students should not fall much below the language requirements for full degree MSc students. European students should be at B2 level within the European framework or better.

Students will receive their acceptance letter and all information relevant to the admission via e-mail. The admission package contains detailed information on how to sign up for courses.

## Accommodation

Exchange students can apply for accommodation before the 15<sup>th</sup> of May for the autumn semester and before the 15<sup>th</sup> of November for the spring semester. Please note that we do not guarantee accommodation for exchange students. However, we do our utmost to find accommodation for all students who apply within the deadlines.
